It has been observed that some of the training institutes conducting Passenger Ship Familiarization (PSF) course have approached this Directorate to obtain permission for appointment of Certificate of Service (COS) holders as course-in-charge. The issue has been examined and it has been decided that the course-in-charge for this course should be Master (FG) COC holder, who must himself have undergone the relevant PSF Course. It would also be desirable if he has some background of working on passenger ship. The other faculty members for conducting the above course should also under PSF course.

All the training institutes must comply with the above requirement while sending therein proposals.
