It has been observed by the Directorate that the DGS approved Maritime Training Institutes [MTIs] conducting post-sea modular courses, are submitting the registered Lease Deeds or Leave and License agreements, the period of which are in variance with the requirement of Para 1.13 of DGS Order 1 of 2003. As per Para 1.13 of the DGS Order No.1 of 2003 read with second Para of letter No. 21-TR (1)/2007 dated 31.10.2007 wherein DGS order 2 of 2007 was issued, the approved maritime training institutes conducting post sea courses are required to submit the lease deed for a minimum period of 3 years with enabling provision for renewal of lease for a further period of 3 years. However, it has been brought to the notice of the Directorate that in some states in India, the state authorities concerned allow registration of the Lease Deed or Leave and License agreements which are for a maximum period of 5 years, including the extendable period, and not beyond.

In view of the difficulties faced by the such approved MTIs, the Director General of Shipping has decided that all the approved Maritime Training Institutes conducting the post-sea modular courses & while applying for shiftingof premise or opening of a new campus for post sea courses, as per Training circular 15 of 2013, shall as far as possible, submit the Lease Deed or Leave and License agreement, duly registered with the concerned State Govt. Authorities, for a period of 3 years, with a provision of renewal for a further period of 3 years. However, in the states where registration procedure does not allow for the extension of lease Deed or Leave and License agreement beyond 5 years including the extendable period, and where the State regulations do not permit the requirement as desired by the aforementioned Para of the said DGS order, such MTIs may register their Lease Deed or Leave and License agreement as per prevailing rules & regulations in that State. In such case a written confirmation by the Institute that the state Government regulation do not permits registration beyond a particular period [as prescribed by state Govt.] shall be submitted to the Directorate.
