The amendments of 2010 (Manila Amendments) to the Standards of Training, Certification & Watch keeping of Seafarers (STCW) Convention reiterate the importance of training for seafarers and the need for seafarers to be certified competent in the different areas of their responsibilities by January, 2017.

- This circular addresses the requirement of training of marine engineering personnel having management responsibilities for the operation and safety of electrical power plants above 1000 volts, as specified in Section A/III-1, A/III-2, A/III-6 & B III/2 of the STCW Code 2010 (Manila Amendments). This training is applicable to engineering officers and electrotechnical officers/electrical officers intending to work on merchant ships fitted with electrical power plants above 1000 volts.
- The course curriculum for the High Voltage Safety and Switch Gear Course for Electro Technical Officers as per the STCW 2010 Amendments was notified in the Annex II of the DGS, GOI Training Circular No.1 of 2011 dated 10.02.11.
- Further, the Director General of Shipping, GoI has decided that this course can be conducted as a modular course, and approved maritime training institutes which are eligible to conduct this course may apply for an approval thereof on the basis of the following guidelines.
