
The Director General of Shipping (DGS) ,Govt. of India ,Mumbai has approved the eligibility criteria for admission to the Pre-Sea 4 years Bachelors in Marine Engineering degree course,1 year course for Graduate Marine Engineers (GME) & 2 years course for Diploma in Marine Engineering (DME) vide this office DGS Circular No.7 of 2005 [F.No.11-TR(21)/97] dated 17.06.2005,training Circular No.6 of 2010] [F.No.TR/pol/8(5)/2010-DSBE]dated 10.06.10, and Training Circular No. 5 of 2012 [F.No.TR/ENG/EXAM/17(2)2010]dated 07.09.12.

2. In terms of the said Circulars of this office, there is an eligibility requirement of atleast 50% marks in English language either in the 10th or 12th standard board examination for seeking an admission to the said DGS,Gol approved maritime training courses. Now, on a calibrated review there of the Director General of Shipping , Govt. of India, in exercise of the powers conferred on him under clause (1) section 456 of the Merchant Shipping Act,1958 as amended ,read with the Ministry of Shipping,Govt of India's Notification No.S.O.No.3144 dated 17.12.60,
