

1. Whereas the Training Circular 07 of 2010 provides Guidelines for conduct of pre-sea training for "Certificate Course in Maritime Catering" (CCMC). As per Item 9 "Evaluation and monitoring of trainee's performance" of the said Circular, the structure of periodical and final examination is stipulated in Annexure 3 and 3A of the said Circular.
2. Whereas Annexure 3A of the Training Circular 07 of 2010 gives the structure of final examination in a tabular format. The final examination consists of a written exam, practical exam, and practical and oral exam.
3. Whereas for objective type questions, an online test was introduced through Training Circular No. 05 of 2011 dated 07 / 06 / 2011 for GP rating and CCMC examination. The Training Circular No. 05 of 2011, item 'c' made online examination for objective type questions mandatory for "Certificate Course in Maritime Catering" (CCMC) since June 2011 exams.
4. Whereas online examination for CCMC exam is being conducted for 65 marks out of 100 and written exam is being conducted for 35 marks out of 100.
5. Whereas written exams for GP rating is conducted completely online and candidates of CCMC are required to appear for online exam as well as written exam.
6. In view of the above, the Directorate has decided to conduct entire written exam online for CCMC exams from June 2019 onwards. The repeater candidates appearing in March 2019 shall appear for written exams as per the existing system. The Annexure 3A of the Training Circular 07 of 2010 is now to be read as follows:


