DGS Circular No.: 29 of 2020 (Amendment to DGS Training Circular No. 12 of 2020 dated 01/04/2020) Sub: Relaxation to the Minimum eligibility criteria for admissions in pre-sea maritime courses, and "Common Entrance Test" (CET) and Online Counselling.		

1. Whereas the Directorate had issued DGS Training Circular No. 12 of 2020 dated 01/04/2020 in which a minimum qualifying marks in the "Common Entrance Test" (CET) was also included in the minimum eligibility criteria for admission in the pre-sea courses. Subsequently an amendment to DGS Training Circular No. 12 of 2020 was issued on 10.07.2020 which now stands cancelled.
2. Whereas the ongoing COVID -19 pandemic caused disruptions in the education system across the country leading to unprecedented uncertainties. The Indian Maritime University has informed that the CET for admissions for the academic year 2020-21 has been cancelled.
3. Accordingly, the following relaxation to DGS Training Circular No. 12 of 2020 dated 01/04/2020 is provided,
 - 3.1 The "Online Common Entrance Test (CET) and Common Counselling" shall not be applicable for admission for the academic year 2020-21.
 - 3.2 The minimum qualifying marks prescribed in the Annexure of Training Circular 12 of 2020 for admission in Diploma, B.Sc. and B.Tech courses is reduced by 1% for the academic year 2020-21.
 - 3.3 The Maritime Training Institutes may follow their own admission process and counselling methodology for the academic year 2020-21, while ensuring that other requirements of Training Circulars are strictly followed.
