DGS Circular No.: 29 of 2020

(Amendment to DGS Training Circular No. 12 of 2020 dated 01/04/2020)

Sub: Relaxation to the Minimum eligibility criteria for admissions in pre-sea maritime courses, and "Common Entrance Test" (CET) and Online Counselling.

- 1. Whereas the Directorate had issued DGS Training Circular No. 12 of 2020 dated 01/04/2020 in which a minimum qualifying marks in the "Common Entrance Test" (CET) was also included in the minimum eligibility criteria for admission in the pre-sea courses. Subsequently an amendment to DGS Training Circular No. 12 of 2020 was issued on 10.07.2020 which now stands cancelled.
- 2. Whereas the ongoing COVID –19 pandemic caused disruptions in the education system across the country leading to unprecedented uncertainties. The Indian Maritime University has informed that the CET for admissions for the academic year 2020-21 has been cancelled.
- 3. Accordingly, the following relaxation to DGS Training Circular No. 12 of 2020 dated 01/04/2020 is provided,
- 3.1 The "Online Common Entrance Test (CET) and Common Counselling" shall not be applicable for admission for the academic year 2020-21.
- 3.2 The minimum qualifying marks prescribed in the Annexure of Training Circular 12 of 2020 for admission in Diploma, B.Sc. and B.Tech courses is reduced by 1% for the academic year 2020-21.
- 3.3 The Maritime Training Institutes may follow their own admission process and counselling methodology for the academic year 2020-21, while ensuring that other requirements of Training Circulars are strictly followed.
