Addendum - I to DGS Order 11 of 2022.

Re- Opening of Maritime Training Institutes under controlled conditions and further relaxation in the issued SOP for Pre-Sea and Post – Sea Institute.

- 1. Whereas, the Directorate vide DGS Order 11 of 2022 dated 22.03.2022 allowed opening of Maritime Training Institutes (MTIs) with 100% capacity for all courses. Further, Online Classes can be continued only till 31.03.2022 and thereafter only physical classes are allowed.
- 2. However, the Directorate has received several requests from MTIs conducting Competency courses and from candidates undergoing these courses to allow continuance of Competency courses on online mode.
- 3. The Directorate has examined the matter and decided to allow online classes to the candidates who have already been enrolled for Competency courses on or before 31.03.2022 till completion of their course.
- 4. MTIs shall ensure that all fresh batches of competency courses planned to be commenced on or after 01.04.2022 has to be in campus with 100% attendance.
- 5. The above extension is only for the competency courses, whereas all other courses have to be conducted as per DGS Order 11 of 2022 dated 22.03.2022.
- 6. This issues with the approval of the Director General of Shipping and Additional Secretary to the Government of India.
