1. In continuation of DGS Circular No.7 of 2005 dated 17.06.2005, Training Circular No.7 of 2008, and Training Circular No.5 of 2012 dated 07.09.2012, the Director General of Shipping [DGS], Government of India, Mumbai has approved the amended eligibility criteria for admission to second year of four year Marine Engineering Degree Course, as per paragraph No.11 (d) of DGS Circular No.7 of 2005 [File No.11-TR (21)/97] dated 17.06.2005.

2. The Directorate has, pursuant thereto, received a number of submissions from the candidates requesting for inclusion of allied Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics Engineering Diplomas in the respective streams.

3. This issue has been deliberated in the Directorate, based on the report recorded in the File No.TR/Misc/9(30)/2011, dated 01.10.2012 as submitted by the Committee constituted for the purpose comprising representatives of MTIs, IMU, and it is decided to include the Diplomas in allied Mechanical /Electrical/Electronics Engineering streams, in addition to that as stated at part (d) of para 11 of the DGS Circular No.7 of 2005 [File No.11-TR(21)/97] dated 17.06.2005, where candidates can laterally join the 2nd year of the four year Marine Engineering Degree Course who have passed three year Diploma Course in the following streams, in addition to the three year regular Diploma Course in Mechanical/Electrical/Electrical and Electronics Engineering from the colleges as approved by the AICTE or the State Board of Technical Education, with minimum 55% aggregate marks in the last year of the Diploma Course;

- (i) Mechanical Engineering Stream - Three years Diploma in (a) Automobile Engineering; (b) Machine tools and Maintenance/ Plant Engineering; (c) Production Technology; (d) Production Engineering; (e) Advanced Diploma in tool and die making.
- (ii) Electrical Engineering Stream - Three years Diploma in Electrical Power System.
- (iii) Electrical & Electronics Engineering Stream - Three years Diploma in (a) Digital Electronics; (b) Electronics and Communications Engineering; (c) Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering; (d) Industrial Electronics; (e) Electronics Engineering; (f) Electronics Production and Maintenance; (g) Electronics; (h) Instrumentation; (i) Instrumentation and Control.

4. Part time or Distance Learning or Correspondence Course or any combination of these will not be considered for the purpose.

5. Candidates selected through the above sub-courses listed at para 3 (i), (ii) & (iii) above, are not eligible for exemption in the examination for Applied Mechanics and Heat Engine subjects of Part A of MEO Class IV and Class II of Certificate of Competency Examinations, as
