DGS Order No. 22 of 2021 Addendum I to DGS Order No. 37 of 2020 dated 10.11.2020

Sub: Non-levy of penalty for Correction in the Seafarer Data – Extension of date w.r.t. DGS Order No. 37 of 2020.

- 1. Whereas the Directorate vide Training Circular 08 of 2019 dated 30.04.2019, has given the responsibility of generation of INDOS number to MTIs for the candidates. Further to ensure the correctness of Seafarer data, the Directorate vide para 10.2 of the same Circular has stated that in case of any errors / corrections in the submitted data (batch detail etc.), the MTI shall directly send email to INDoS cell requesting for corrections to be made with attached scan copy of Passport. The MTI shall be penalized and charged Rs. 3000 /- for each correction.
- 2. The Directorate vide DGS Order No. 37 of 2020 dated 10.11.2020 has made a partial modification to the above circular by relaxing the provision of fine of Rs.3000/- for the period of three months from 10.11.2020 to 09.02.2021 vide DGS Order No. 9 of 2021 dated 10.02.2021, the said period was further extended from 10.02.2021 to 09.05.2021.
- 3. Taking cognizance of the Pandemic situation, it has been decided to further extend this period from 10.05.2021 to 30.11.2021.
