Addendum - VI to DGS Order 28 of 2020.

Sub.- Re-Opening of Maritime Training Institutes under controlled conditions and further relaxation in the issued SOP for Pre-Sea and Post - Sea.

- Whereas, the DGS Order No. 13 of 2021 dated 18.03.2021 amended the Standard Operating Procedures issued vide DGS Order No. 28 of 2020 dated 01.10.2020 to enable safe resumption of more training/teaching activities at Maritime Training Institutes (MTIs).
- 2. Whereas, Section II of DGS Order No. 13 of 2021 dated 18.03.2021 allowed MTI for extension of validity of Short term STCW certificates from 18 months to Five Year after candidate completes the practical at MTI.
- 3. Whereas, taking note of the Covid 19 pandemic situation and lockdown orders issued by the authorities, DGS Order 14 of 2021 dated 05.04.2021 was issued as deferment of DGS Order 13 of 2021 dated 18.03.2021.
- 4. Whereas, the overall prevailing condition of Covid-19 pandemic in India has been remarkably improved in most of the states of India. The Competent Authorities have now allowed resumption of Education & Training within their jurisdiction.
- 5. Whereas, the Directorate has received many representations from MTIs to allow candidates in MTI campus for Pre-Sea courses. Whereas Post-Sea MTIs have requested to increase batch capacity from existing 33% to at least 50% for the seafarer to attend practicals. This may help seafarer to complete Part B of the course certificate.

- 6. Whereas, the Directorate has examined the request received from MTIs and decided to reinstate the deferred Order No. 13 of 2021 dated 18.03.2021 with amendment as per attached Annexure.
- 7. This Order shall be subject to any further orders/SoP/ Guidelines issued by Government of India or the State Government/ any/ concerned authority within the jurisdiction of which the Maritime Training Institute is located.
