DGS Order: 04 of 2024

Subject: Amendments to International Code on the Enhanced Programme of Inspections during surveys of Bulk Carriers and Oil Tankers, 2011 (2011 ESPCODE) and its applicability—reg.

Whereas, the Government of India has ratified the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974, and the Convention entered into force on 25th May 1980 through accession. The Convention as modified by the protocol of 1988 entered into force on 22nd November 2000 through accession. Article 1 of the Convention mandates general obligation of the Government to undertake all measures which may be necessary to give effect to the Convention.

Whereas, the Merchant Shipping Act 1958, as amended incorporates the Convention and is defined at Section 3 (37) as "Safety Convention" means the Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea signed in London on the 1st day of November, 1974 as amended from time to time. Further, the mandatory Codes as indicated in the Convention and its amendments from time to time is in effect and applicable to the vessels.

Whereas, the Recognised Organizations (RO) were notified vide notification dated 26thDecember 2014 and as indicated, an agreement is entered into with each RO to carryoutsurveys and certification as per the Convention. The DGS Order 6 of 2013 advises ROto follow the mandatory Codes of IMO while carrying out survey and certification.

Noting that, IMO has issued various amendments to the International Code on the Enhanced Programme of Inspections during surveys of Bulk Carriers and Oil Tankers,2011 (2011 ESP CODE) from time to time, which is annexed to this Order at Annexure-1 are applicable to Indian vessels. The stakeholders are therefore advised to be guided by this Order towards compliance with the provisions to give full effect to the ESP Code, as amended.
